110kV Kigali Ring Network which was a project for energy efficiency boost through reduction of losses in Kigali Grid Network.

CEC had a contract to supply and the installation of materials for the extension and upgrade of Mount Kigali substation, construction of new Gahanga substation and installation of a second transformer at Birembo substation.

- This project consists of Survey, Design and Construction of 90 km of Medium Voltage & 226 km of Low Voltage Overhead distribution lines, Installation of 71 transformers that will put almost 10,000 new customers connected to the grid. The project will be implemented in 6 sectors located in Karongi District and 5 sectors in Rutsiro District.
- Plant Design, Supply, Erection and Commissioning of 110kV Mukungwa-Nyabihu Transmission Lines, 110kV/30kV Nyabihu Substation with Mukungwa Line Bay, Extension of Musha Substation & Construction of 30kV.







AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

The Government of Rwanda targets to increase urbanization rate from 18% to 35% in the next 5 years to support economic growth.

An urbanization of 35% by 2024 is the expression of an increase of urban population by about 2.7 Million people.

The Housing Market study done in City of Kigali (IGC 2018) showed that 700,000 new dwelling units were needed by 2028, where 70% dwelling units lay in Affordable Housing category.

The Government of Rwanda initiated the Affordable Housing program to find the solutions of housing challenges to low and middle-income communities all over the country.

To support the Government of Rwanda bridge the existing housing gaps, EPC Africa Group has introduced a real estate development company called EPCA Housing, a special purpose vehicle created to address the shortage of affordable housing in the country, EPCA Housing is planning to construct 3,000 apartments in the next 5 years (2021-2025).

In Zimbabwe, EPCA is currently engaged in the development of the 25MW Solar farm which is situated in Gweru.

The Solar farm is meant to feed power into the electricity grid. The aim of the project is to alleviate and tone down the power shortages in the country.

Our intention is to use sustainable energy for the development of the nation of Zimbabwe.

The 25MW Plant will service areas in and around Gweru. The electricity generated from this project will support the local industries in the area to increase their productivity in the country.

In the Pipeline, we have other strategic Power Supply Projects to be launched soon in Kenya, DRC and Malawi.
